#### IQAC Meeting Minutes

#### Agenda:

#### Proceedings:

Dr. Mukambika G. S., Coordinator welcomed the members of IQAC, Alva's College (Autonomous), Moodubidre. Dr. Mukambika G. S., Coordinator, IQAC placed the agenda of the meeting before IQAC members for deliberations.

The details are as follows:

#### Agenda 1: Presentation of the minutes of the previous meeting.

The IQAC Coordinator presented the suggestions given by both the experts in the previous meeting.

#### Agenda 2: Approval Academic plan for the year 2025-26

Department plan presentations were done by deans and HoDs of different departments.

#### Suggestions by Dr. Chandrashekar External Expert, IQAC:

He congratulated the entire department for their presentation and provided some valuable suggestions for improvement.

The details are as follows:

**Role of IQAC:** As part of streamlining the presentation process and ensuring clarity in communication, all IQAC members have been advised to maintain uniformity in their presentation formats. To achieve this, it has been suggested that members adopt a standard method of organizing content—either department-wise or faculty-wise. This helps in presenting data and insights in a more structured and easily understandable manner.

**Role of Staff:** Each faculty member was encouraged to become more actively involved in research activities, with a particular emphasis on increasing the number of research publications. Faculty were urged to enhance their academic productivity by contributing to high-quality journals and engaging in meaningful research work. It was also suggested that every department ensure all faculty members publish at least one research article, thereby promoting a research-driven academic culture across the institution.

-While discussing the Faculty Development Programme (FDP), it was recommended that such programs be opened to participants from other institutions as well, to foster external academic collaboration and knowledge sharing. Additionally, it was advised that the FDP be conducted in a blended format, with three days held offline (in-person) and two days conducted online, to maximize participation and engagement.

**Upgradation of Students:** It was emphasized that students should be encouraged to participate more actively in skill-based programs to enhance their employability and practical knowledge. It was also suggested that these skill-based programs should be open to all students, across departments and disciplines, ensuring equal opportunity and wider participation. Additionally, while planning such skill development initiatives, it was recommended that the programs be designed with unique and innovative ideas to make them more engaging, relevant, and impactful. The external expert concluded by stating- True institutional excellence is achieved not just through financial strength, but by fostering a culture where quality assurance, academic productivity, and skill development go hand in hand—empowering staff to lead through research, students to thrive through skills, and systems to function with clarity and purpose.

**Suggestions by Dr. Kurian , Principal Alva's college(Autonomous):**

- He appreciated the presentations from each department and offered constructive suggestions for further improvement.
- Suggested making necessary changes in academic plans to better align with institutional goals.
  - Encouraged faculty members to publish their research articles regularly.
  - Advised faculty to ensure that every student completes at least one soft skill program.
  - Explained the institutional benefits and incentives available for faculty involved in research activities.
  - Suggested IQAC members to show more vision and highlight progress and innovations within their departments.
  - Recommended adding more e-content to presentations to enhance clarity and engagement.
  - Advised departments to clearly mention mentorship programs in their presentations and reports.
  - Encouraged the conduction of more objective-based programs focused on measurable outcomes.
  - Stressed that course objectives and outcomes should be well-defined and measurable.
  - Emphasized the need to involve all faculty members in academic planning and decision-making processes.

**Suggestions by Narayana Shetty Registrar Evaluation Alva's college, Autonomous**

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- Advised to include student or public feedback about the program in the presentations.
- Recommended mentioning both the merits and demerits of the program in the PPT.
- Suggested clearly stating the strategies being used to achieve academic or program objectives.
- Encouraged departments to highlight any new techniques or methods being adopted.
- Proposed that marks be divided as 50% for tests and 50% for other academic activities.
- Recommended involving students more actively in SWAYAM or SWOOC (Self-paced Web-based Open Online Courses) courses.
- Encouraged departments to try new and innovative experiments or approaches to improve learning outcomes.

All the items on the agenda of the meeting were approved with minor modifications. It was decided to have one more IQAC meeting for the departmental plan presentation for the academic year 2025-26. The meeting concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Kurian, IQAC and Principal, Alva's College (Autonomous), Moodubidire.
