

Unlike one-point perspective, which has a single vanishing point, two-point perspective utilizes two vanishing points on the horizon line. This allows for a more dynamic and realistic representation of objects, particularly those with multiple sides visible to the viewer.

Key features of two-point perspective:

- **Two vanishing points:** These points are located on the horizon line and represent the points where parallel lines converge.
- **Horizon line:** This imaginary line represents the eye level of the viewer.
- **Vanishing point lines:** These lines extend from the corners of the object towards the respective vanishing points.
- **Vertical lines:** These lines remain parallel and do not converge.





3. Theory Classes

As part of the NCC Air Wing training, cadets are introduced to key subjects such as **aviation history**, **meteorology**, **air navigation**, **and airframes**, which lay a strong foundation for understanding the field of aviation. **Aviation history** familiarizes cadets with the significant milestones, inventions, and pioneers who contributed to the development of air travel. **Meteorology** helps cadets understand weather conditions, cloud formations, wind patterns, and their importance in aviation operations. **Air navigation** equips them with skills in map reading, use of compasses, and understanding navigation aids to plan and follow flight paths effectively. **Airframes** training provides knowledge about the basic structure and components of an aircraft, including wings, fuselage, and landing gear, as well as their function in flight. These topics enhance the technical knowledge of cadets and spark interest in careers related to the Indian Air Force and aviation sector.

4. Rifle Training:

5. Aero Modelling Programme in ATC Camp.

Aero Modelling training is an exciting and integral part of the NCC Air Wing curriculum, designed to introduce cadets to the fundamentals of aviation technology through hands-on experience. This training involves building, designing, and flying model aircraft, which helps cadets understand aerodynamic principles, aircraft structure, and control mechanisms. It enhances their creativity, technical skills, and teamwork while fostering a deep interest in aviation. Through practical sessions and guided demonstrations, cadets gain insights into lift, thrust, drag, and stability — the key forces in flight. Aero Modelling not only instils discipline and precision but also inspires cadets to pursue careers in the field of aeronautics and defence services

Control line aero modelling is a fascinating aspect of aero modelling training in NCC, where cadets learn to fly model aircraft that are tethered to the pilot by two control lines. These lines allow the operator to control the aircraft's pitch by moving the handle, enabling the model to climb, dive, or fly level in a circular path. Unlike free-flight or radio-controlled models, control line models require the pilot to physically follow the aircraft's movement in a circular area, which improves reflexes, coordination, and understanding of flight mechanics. This type of training teaches cadets about basic flight controls, engine handling, and structural design, while also building patience, focus, and technical aptitude. It is an excellent foundation for those aspiring to delve deeper into aviation and aeronautical engineering

This type of training is commonly used in obstacle course races (OCR) such as the Spartan Race and Tough Mudder, military training, fitness programs, and even rehabilitation settings. The main purpose of obstacle training is to push individuals beyond their usual limits by combining functional movements, cardiovascular challenges, and strength-building exercises. Participants navigate through obstacles like climbing walls, crawling under barriers, or swinging from monkey bars, all of which target different muscle groups and improve coordination. Physically, this type of training promotes full-body strength, endurance, and flexibility, while also enhancing mental resilience, problem-solving, and focus. Whether for general fitness, teambuilding, or competitive racing, obstacle training offers both psychological and physical benefits, building confidence, mental toughness, and a strong sense of accomplishment. Moreover, it is a versatile form of exercise, suitable for people of all fitness levels, as it can be scaled to suit beginners or advanced athletes.

Republic day parade Camp:




