Students told to develop a positive mindset

MANGALURU, DHNS: Trustee of Alva's Education Foundation Vivek Alva said success and recognition in life could be achieved only when individuals were willing to accept responsibility.

Speaking after inaugurating 'Ankura', the induction programme for the first-year students on Monday, he said students, alongside academic excellence, should strive to develop a strong character and compassionate mindset.

Alva's began its educational journey in 1998 with just 25 students, two departments, and 11 faculty members. Today, it has grown into a institution offering 54 academic programmes, with 122 classrooms, 188 faculty members, and 3,191 students. True strength and brand value of the institution lie in its students, he said.

He urged students to understand the sacrifices and expectations of their parents

and make the best use of the educational opportunities available to them.

He said students must carry responsibilities along with their dreams. "Active participation in academic and extra-curricular activities helps in personality development. Students should remain focused on their goals and avoid unnecessary distractions."

He said students must also develop the ability to adapt to changing technologies.

Principal Dr Kurian said a safe and inspiring environment was essential for students' growth, and no achievement was possible in an atmosphere of insecurity. "The future of a nation is shaped within classrooms. Therefore, educational institutions must foster confidence, creativity, and leadership qualities among students."

He advised students to develop positive-mindset and stay away from negativity.
